



**Title/position:** Street Team Volunteer

**Description:** Our Street Team Volunteers assist with public outreach and raising awareness throughout the community. These volunteers help out at a variety of shelter-run and outside events around the community. Street Team Volunteers often table at community events and provide flyers, pamphlets, and information about the shelter's services and adoptable animals.

**Responsibilities:**

- Assist with public outreach and events throughout the year such as Muddy Paws 5K, Paws for Celebration, Santa Photos & Holiday Bazaar, Petco tabling events, and more
- Attend fairs, festivals, parades, and other events to spread awareness
- Hand out educational materials
- Educate the public about shelter services and available pets
- Represent the shelter at speaking events in schools, libraries, etc.
- Spread the word about shelter programs and upcoming events
- Recruit new volunteers, fosters, and adopters at events

**Requirements:** Volunteers must be at least 16 years of age or older and have access to reliable transportation to and from events, and to and from the shelter to pick up event bins. They must also be comfortable with public speaking and able to communicate the shelter's mission with others. This position has low-moderate levels of animal contact.

**Time commitment:** Opportunities are available year-round, typically on Saturdays or Sundays with some weekday availability. Shifts last anywhere between 2-5 hours. Volunteers must sign up to help with at least one event per month.

**Location:** Mainly throughout the Greater Lowell Area, occasionally to other areas in MA and NH.

**Benefits:** Make a difference in the lives of local shelter pets by providing the public with information about shelter services and adoptable animals. Grow your skills, meet new people, and join a network of others that share your passion.
